Community guidelines



Our basic expectations are set out below and are in keeping with our values. As a Maven Club member you agree to abide by them.

Respectful communication. Members should engage in respectful and edifying communication at all times. Avoid insults, harassment, or demeaning language. You don't have to agree with everything but be nice when you don't agree.

Privacy. Peer times work because we embrace vulnerability. All members must be respectful about the privacy of others and not share personal information without consent.

Don't spam. Please don't use this platform to self-promote. We are supportive of what you are doing and will endeavour to encourage you but share about your venture appropriately.

Keep it relevant. Posts and discussions should be relevant. We can all go off at tangent but try to stick within the themes.

Credit where credit is due. When sharing information or content from other sources, members should credit the original source. Give credit where it's due and others will do the same for you.

Cautious and constructive criticism. When offering criticism, it should be constructive and aimed at helping and improving, rather than disparaging or belittling. Be slow to speak and quick to encourage.

No illegal activities. Discussions or content promoting illegal activities are forbidden.

Hate speech and discrimination are banned. Content promoting hate or discrimination based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or disability is strictly prohibited.

No explicit content. Sharing explicit, adult, or NSFW (not safe for work) content is not permitted.

Report rule violations. Members should report any content or behaviour that violates the community guidelines.
